**2.Wetlands Application # 2021-1449** submitted by Bayshore Design, LLC on behalf of Nancy B. Simon. This request is to construct a 50' rip-rap revetment within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on LaGrange Creek, at Tax Map Parcel # 14-6-6. 49 LaGrange Lane

**3.Coastal Primary Sand Dune Application # 2021-1508** submitted by Gary Jackson Sears Jackson Revoc. Trust. This request is for a new 92' groin with 16' spur within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on the Rappahannock River, at Tax Map Parcel # 40(8)3. 131 Dee Dee Ln

**4.Wetlands Application # 2021-1599** submitted by Sidney M. Harrison, Jr. Irrevocable Trust C/O Deborah Glenn Harrison. This request is to move two existing rip rap groins, improve breakwater to 165' long by 4.5' tall by 20' wide base, with a 30' return on the southern end. Install a 9' tall by 141'long Redi-Rock wall with two 16' long returns on a 2x7' compacted stone base lined with geofabric. Backfill the area 45' wide by 175' long by an average of 2' tall with clean backfill sand and plant with 2" Alterniflora plugs 1' on center. Install a 66' long by 16' base by 4' tall marsh sill, backfilled with a 20' wide by 66' long by an average of 2' of clean fill sand and plant with 2" Alterniflora plugs 1' on center within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. 3. Chairman opens the Hearing for comments from the public.
  - A. Each speaker will give his or her name and address for the record.
  - B. Each speaker or individual will be given one opportunity to speak.
  - C. All comments and/or remarks **will be** addressed to the Wetlands Board, **not** to the audience or the applicant.
  - D. Comments from individuals - allowed three (3) minutes each.
  - E. Comments from speaker(s) representing a group:
    - i. Must represent four (4) or more individuals;
    - ii. Individuals must stand and acknowledge that they are being represented by the speaker and that they forfeit their individual time to speak;
    - iii. Are allowed 12 minutes to make their presentation(s)
