Call to Order

The June 14, 2022, meeting of the Middlesex County Wetlands Board was called to order by Chairman Dolezal, at 9:57 A.M. in the Boardroom of the Historic Courthouse, Saluda, Virginia.

Minutes

The Board considered the minutes of the May 10, 2022, meeting. The motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Boyd and seconded by Mrs. Sanders and carried with a unanimous vote.

Public Hearings

A. Wetlands Application # 2022-0936 submitted by Kenneth Tota. This request is to install 220 linear feet of riprap revetment within the Wetlands Board’s jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on the Piankatank River, at Tax Map Parcel # 43-32D. 391 Ballantyne Road

Roger McKinley was present to represent the application and to explain the proposed project.

Chairman Dolezal opened the hearing for comments from the public.

There being no additional comments, the public portion of the hearing was closed.

Chairman Dolezal began a brief period of questions and comments between the Board and the agent.

Mr. Armstead and Mr. Laughton had no comments. Mr. Boyd confirmed that it was behind wetland grasses – yes. Mrs. Sanders stated it was a good project. Chairman Dolezal express the large fetch, steep drop, no loss of vegetation, and repairs to damage – yes. Mr. Madden asked for clarification on the jurisdictional boundary of the Wetlands Board – agent stated that there were Wetlands jurisdiction on the project. Mr. Longest explained that there were grasses, and the stone revetment was within the 1.5 times MHW of the project, even with no impact to grasses, a permit would be required.

There being no further questions or comments from the Board, Chairman Dolezal asked for disposition of the application.

The motion to approve the application as submitted was made by Mr. Laughton and seconded by Mr. Boyd and carried unanimously with an 18 Month time limit.
